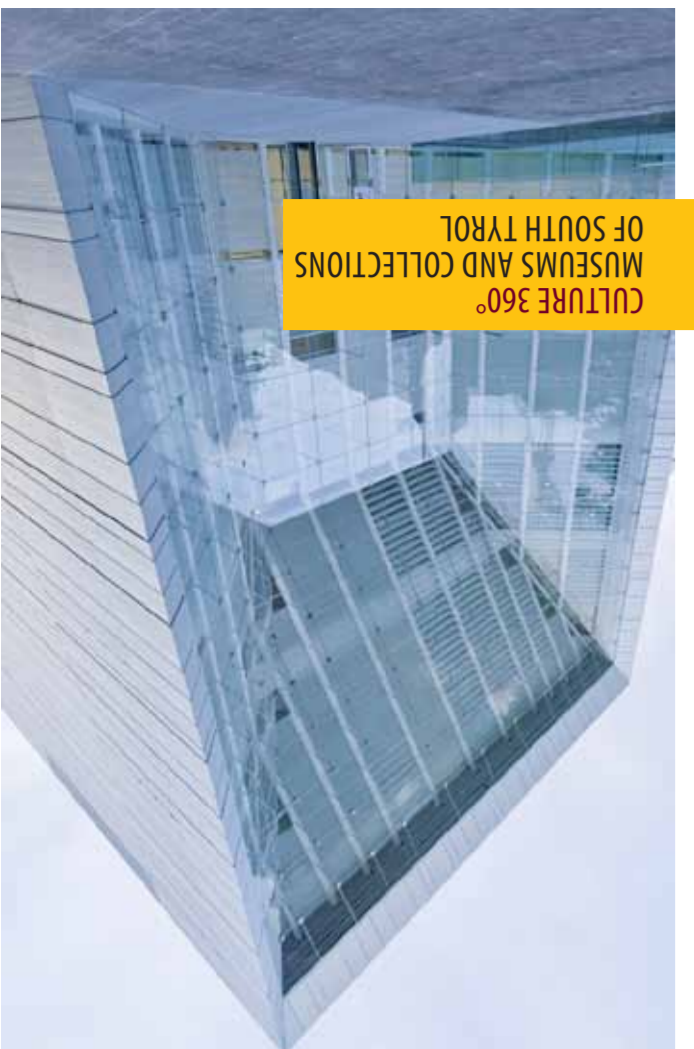

The dynastic castle of the Counts of Tyrol, who gave their name to the province, is a solid memorial of Tyrolean history. Since 2003 it has housed the South Tyrol Museum of History. An interactive tour guides visitors through the main events during the centuries of the castle's development. The keep houses an exhibition covering 20 floors, on South Tyrol in the 20th century, on multimedia stations, audio and film presentations along with contemporary documents depict the long road to South Tyrol's autonomous status. The recent past is shown through historical documents and everyday objects.

The Schneeberg between the Passeier and Ridsnau valleys is home to the experience mine and hut at an altitude of 2355 m above sea level. They are the starting point for paths around the mine as well as guided tours above and below ground. From the Middle Ages to 1967, miners lived and worked here in inconceivably hard conditions. Today, the refuge, the display area, a smiddy and the mine document the history of the most important lead and zinc mine in Tyrol. The experience mine and the hut are only accessible on foot.

The archaeology museum has since 1998 been the home for the 5,000-year-old glacier mummy Ötzi – "The Man from the Ice". As well as the original finds, there are models, reconstructions, videos and interactive multimedia stations that offer a stimulating and entertaining view of the early history of the southern Alpine region. The first floor is dedicated to the Man from the Ice. The objects found with the mummy give a unique picture of the life of the inhabitants of the Alps over 5,000 years ago, while the museum also covers the pre- and early history of South Tyrol up to the Middle Ages. The entire museum is until 13 January 2013 dedicated to the "Ötzi20" exhibition.

The natural history museum is housed in the former administrative building of Emperor Maximilian I and offers visitors a geological and biological excursion into one of the most diverse regions of the Alps. On an surface area of 900 m², arranged on two floors, visitors are led through the various natural habitats of the region, from the screes of the high mountains, down through the forested belt and into the river valleys. The formation and current appearance of the South Tyrolean landscapes are succinctly illustrated on the basis of selected examples. Numerous special exhibitions supplement the permanent exhibition.
